The street protests that erupted in Tunisia in December 2010 and spread quickly throughout the Middle East surprised not only the entrenched dictators of the region but also international observers who collectively had taken for granted the durability of Middle Eastern authoritarianism. Specifically, the Arab Spring uprisings debunked the prevailing notion that youth were disengaged from political life by their economic exclusion and tight regime control of their mobilization. Indeed, the one consistent feature across the uprisings, whether peaceful or violent, was the key role played by young people. What has remained unclear is why youth became the vanguards of the Arab Spring protests and why they have not played a more prominent role in the transitions that followed. To address these questions, the authors in this volume use updated data sets on demography, employment, education, inequality, social media and public sentiment to examine the underlying socioeconomic conditions of young people in the Middle East at the time of the uprisings and offer a mosaic of analytical explanations linking those conditions from 2009-2011 to the revolts of 2010-2012. The findings in the volume confirm the inadequacy of traditional narrow explanations rooted in demographic profiles, economic grievances or political exclusion in accounting for the complex socioeconomic dynamics facing youth and societies at large in the Middle East in the period leading up to the Arab Spring. The contributors emphasize the fundamental institutional rigidities in the region's policy space and evaluate potential approaches to policy reform that can promote youth inclusion and help transform the region's political economies in the post Arab Spring environment of

persistent economic volatility, social unrest and political instability.

This study starts with design considerations, the functional behaviour, and key characteristics of the microring resonator and add/drop ring resonators allowing the performance of higher order filters. For nonlinear materials the basic equations to describe the formation and propagation of different types of optical solitons are well known. The resonance condition is satisfied when the circumference of the microring resonators, or generally the round-trip length, is equal to an integer multiple of the optical wavelength inside the medium. The chaotic behaviour of the multi output signals generated from these devices can be filtered using appropriate parameters. Optical chaos is observed in many non-linear optical systems. One of the most common examples is a microring resonator. Chaotic behaviour has been considered as a nonlinear property in physics, electronics and communication. Soliton is a self-reinforcing solitary wave (a wave packet or pulse)

that maintains its shape while it travels at constant speed. Among all the types of solitons, optical vector solitons draw the most attention due to their wide range of applications, particularly in generating ultrafast pulses and light control technology. Dark solitons are much less stable due to the cross-interaction between the two polarization components. The bus waveguides of the microring resonator are cladded by silica, which serves both to improve modal confinement and facilitate wafer bonding for structural support. The source of nonlinear reaction is related to harmonic motion of bound electrons under the influence of an applied field. The total polarization  $P$  induced by electric dipoles is not linear in the electric field. The extent that the signal degrades depends on the purity of the glass and the wavelength of the transmitted light. This refractive index variation is responsible for the nonlinear optical effects of self-focusing, self-phase modulation and modulation instability, and is the basis for Kerr-lens mode locking. The quality factor of a resonator is a measure of the sharpness of the resonance. Therefore the optimum fabrication process can be obtained with respect to higher quality factor of the device. The phenomenon of optical bistability within the system arises from a combination of the nonlinearity in the radiation-matter interaction and of a feedback mechanism."

The book draws on interviews and self-reflective insider ethnography with a variety of practitioners, particularly contemporary pagans in Britain and north America from druid and heathen traditions, to elucidate what shamans do.; Wallis looks at historical and archaeological sources to elucidate whether 'Celtic' and 'northern' shamanism may have existed; he explores contemporary pagan engagements with prehistoric sacred sites such as Stonehenge and Avebury, and discusses the controversial use by neo-Shamans of indigenous (particularly native American) shamanism. Rather than discuss neo-Shamans as inauthentic, invalid culture-stealers, Wallis offers a more detailed and complex appraisal. He makes it clear that scholars must be prepared to give up some of their hold over knowledge, and not only be aware of these neo-Shamanic approaches but also engage in a serious dialogue with such 'alternative' histories.
