Rigorous Curriculum Design

This report outlines the development of a new framework within which the opportunity for ecotourism may be set. Based on existing approaches used in the field of resources management, the framework incorporates ideas from the recreation opportunity spectrum and modifies ideas presented in the tourism opportunity spectrum to specifically address ecotourism. Termed the ecotourism opportunity spectrum, it has eight components: access, other resource-related activities, attractions offered, existing infrastructures, social interaction, level of skill and knowledge, acceptance of visitor impacts, and acceptance for a management regime. Aspects of the ecotourism opportunity spectrum framework are applied to northern Ontario ecotourism areas that had been previously identified using a geographic information systems approach. The report also presents recommendations on evaluating the priority of ecotourism activities and opportunities, and on assessing the significance of the environmental impacts that may result.
